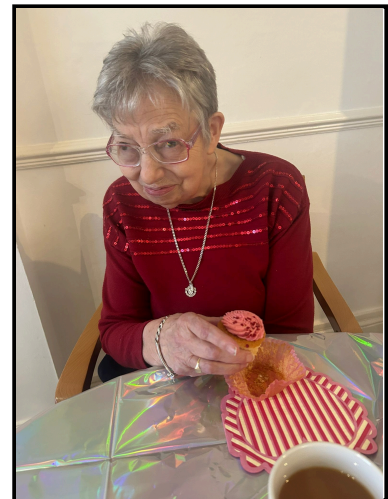
This month it's 'Staff in the Spotlight' with an interview with Mandy, one of our lovely Support Workers. See for yourself!
